



An all-rounder conquers the world of air travel

Almost 100.000 Compact baggage carts are ensuring smooth operations in airport terminals worldwide

Basis for the proven and universally accepted excellence of EXPRESSO's baggage carts is the exclusive use of top-quality materials and surface treatment methods. Furthermore, the Compact's compatibility with systems for trolley retrieval, storage, and rental offered by the Kassel (Germany) based supplier as an "all in one solution", is another decisive feature. The Compact is fitted with large advertising surfaces that can be used lucratively by the airport operator for additional earnings.

For more than 10 years in worldwide use, EXPRESSO's successful and established range of Compact baggage carts is now available in its current generation. Also developed in close cooperation with airport clients, the Mark V is based on the proven technology of its predecessors. Nonetheless, it offers several new features and complies with prevailing tastes.

Apart from passenger safety aspects, the demands placed on baggage carts by airport operators play an important role: The choice of materials, such as aluminium and stainless steel, permit optimum adaptation to the climatic conditions of different countries. All plastic parts of the Compact are available in standard RAL or in customer specific colours, thus supporting the architectural ambience and interior design of an airport terminal. Thanks to its high loading capacity and compact construction, EXPRESSO's baggage carts are an ideal partner both in the business class and the tourist class areas of the terminal.

All the constructional advantages of the Compact are standard features that also underline its capabilities as an all-rounder: The automatic parking brake is released by pressing the push handle. Moreover, the supplementary handle bar simplifies pushing and steering. The wedge shaped brake block achieves 30% more braking power than conventional systems, and the large wheels with rugged ball bearings help to cushion shock loads. These combined features enable the fully laden trolley to be manoeuvred easily, also in tight spaces.

Wheel guards keep the luggage from getting soiled, and a large front bumper prevents injuries and damage. The passenger's luggage rests securely on the inclined (18°) load area, which also provides a high degree of safety on ramps or when negotiating curbs. A large wire basket offers generous space for the passenger's hand luggage. Safety instructions for the trolley's use are clearly visible in the push handle.

Due to the modular system, the replacement of worn parts is possible without any special tools. Whether in Singapore, Copenhagen or Rome, its serviceability, functionality, and quality distinguish the Compact as an innovative all-rounder
