This self-service trolley with automatic parking brake and two load platform sizes provides the necessary safety and mobility

All too frequently, customers in beverage markets are faced with rattling, bumpy trolleys that are equally difficult to push and manoeuvre with and without load. Moreover, loading/unloading e.g. heavy beverage crates into an automobile is a strenuous task that can be dangerous on sloping parking lots – especially in bad weather. It doesn't take much for the loaded trolley to become a “runaway”, with considerable risk of injury to persons, and damage to vehicles or buildings. EXPRESSO Deutschland GmbH, in Kassel, Germany has now introduced two self-service trolley versions that meet all the demands for untroubled, safe, and ergonomic shopping, thanks to a whole range of smart and practical details plus high-quality components.

Modern design plus extra safety

Apart from the modern design, an outstanding feature is the automatic parking brake that has proved its reliability and effectiveness on more than 100.000 EXPRESSO baggage carts. It is released simply by pressing the push handle. Wedge-shaped brake blocks provide 30% more braking force than conventional systems, and the extra large fixed & swivel castors with dust and waterproof deep-groove ball bearings reliably absorb any shock loads. This enables the fully laden EXPRESSO self-service trolley to traverse doorsills easily, whereby manoeuvring in the market and on the parking lot is simple and effortless. The loading platform is inclined toward the rear to ensure that the goods remain secure – also on sloping parking lots.

With two optional platform lengths, the self-service trolley is suitable for loading either two or three beverage crates behind each other. The large wire basket provides ample space for single bottles, snacks, etc. Another special feature is the large advertising panel of tough plastic, which the market operator can use for additional revenue. Similarly, the user finds additional advertising and/or operating instructions in the push handle. Deflectors on the rear wheels prevent the load becoming soiled, and a plastic bumper strip provides protection against damage and/or injury. EXPRESSO's new self-service trolleys are practical and safe “shopping companions”, whose excellent handling will be appreciated and remembered by customers.
