



Change from strenuous rolling to simple, ergonomic transport of heavy tyres

Frequently, large heavy tyres are literally "manhandled" by single persons all day long. This is extremely time consuming and involves considerable risks to health. In such cases, a strong assistant in the shape of an ergonomically designed hand truck is an invaluable help.

Since decades, hand trucks from EXPRESSO, the transport equipment supplier in Kassel, Germany are in worldwide use. With EXPRESSO's new aluminium tyre truck, up to eight tyres or complete wheels can be transported quickly and easily.

Time is money

Especially the customers of tyre dealers expect their vehicles to be back on the road in the shortest time: With its load of new tyres, the trolley is pushed directly to the tyre-mounting press. When the new tyres have been mounted, the old tyres are removed quickly and conveniently in a single operation.

The tyre truck's simple and precise handling is of particular advantage if tyres must be moved considerable distances from a depot or to a central collecting point.

Similarly, precise manoeuvring of a loaded trolley through narrow spaces in assembly shops with limited freedom of movement is very easy. The stacked tyres are simply grasped by the scissor-shaped manipulator, which is operated by means of two handles. The subsequent transport process is requires no effort, because the load is positioned ideally with a low center of gravity.

Moreover, the truck can be rested on its angled skids for convenient loading of the tyres from or into a vehicle. Alternatively, inspection of the tyres for damage or wear is a simple matter.

EXPRESSO's aluminium modular system for hand trucks is rational and economical: Should a worn part have to be replaced – no problem! Every component is also available as a spare part. In this way, EXPRESSO transport equipment is always kept in top condition, and its useful life is multiplied several times.
